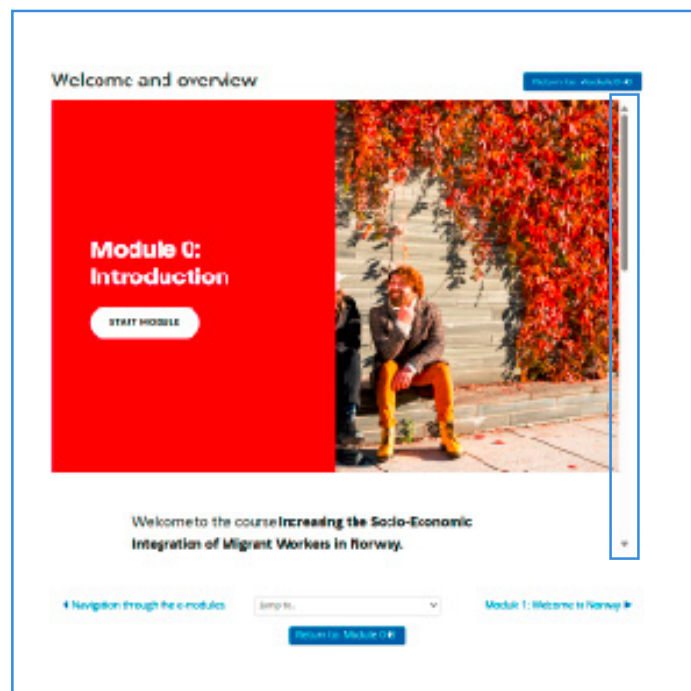

Here are the instructions on how to navigate the e-modules easily.

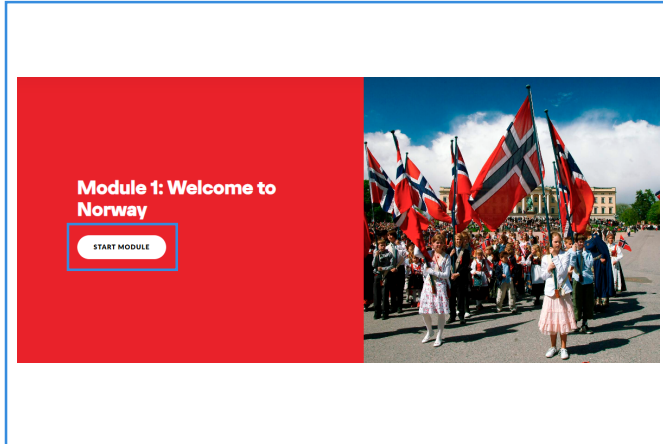
General

To view the contents on the screen be sure to use the vertical scroll bar that appears in your browser window. Use the mouse scroll to proceed.

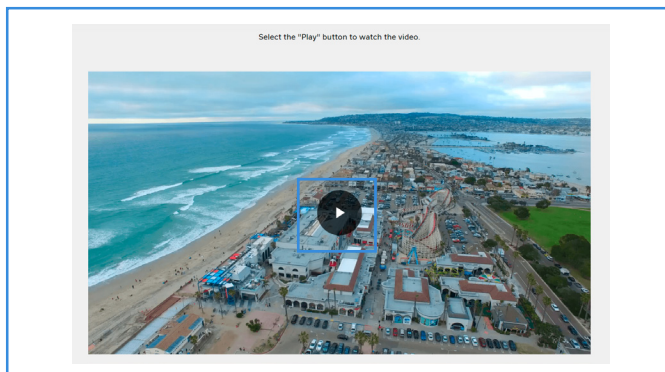
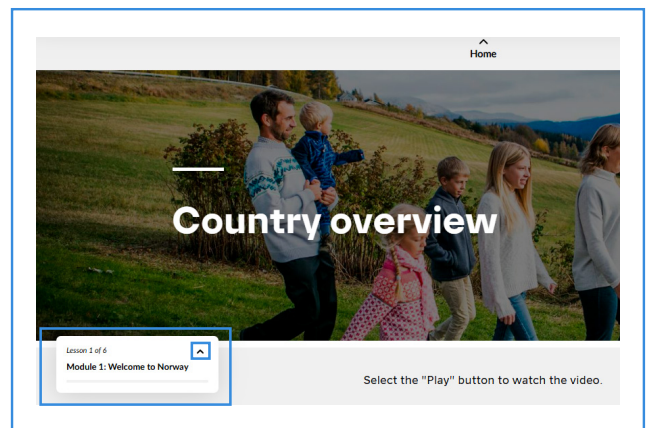


Course Lessons

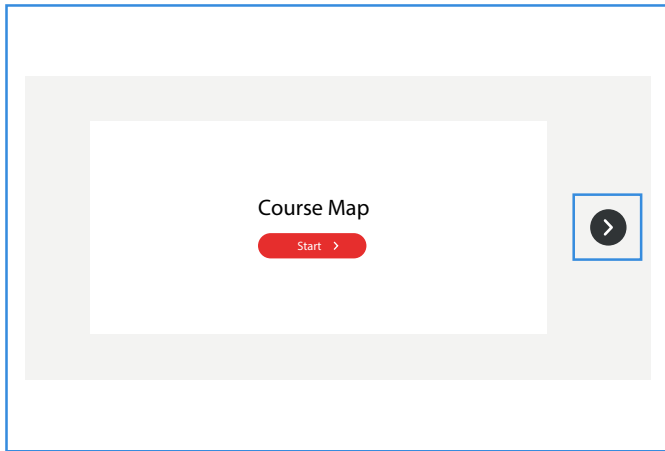


When you have entered an e-module, click on the “Start Module” button to begin.

Each e-module includes a drop-down menu with content titles. This menu is located at the bottom left of the screen. Click on the arrow pointing up to display the titles and vice versa to hide it. This menu will allow you to move easily between lessons. The lesson titles follow a linear logic, i.e. they will only be available in the menu as you progress.

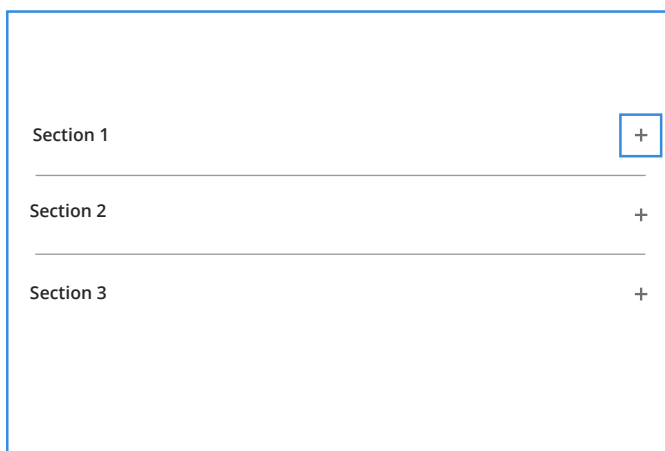
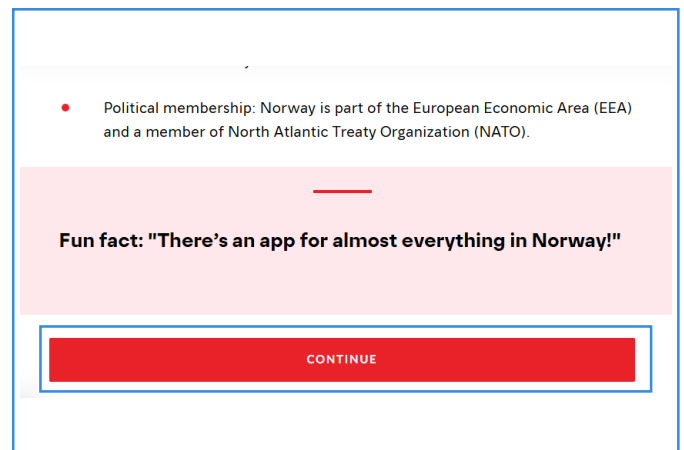


To reproduce videos in an e-module, click on the play button.

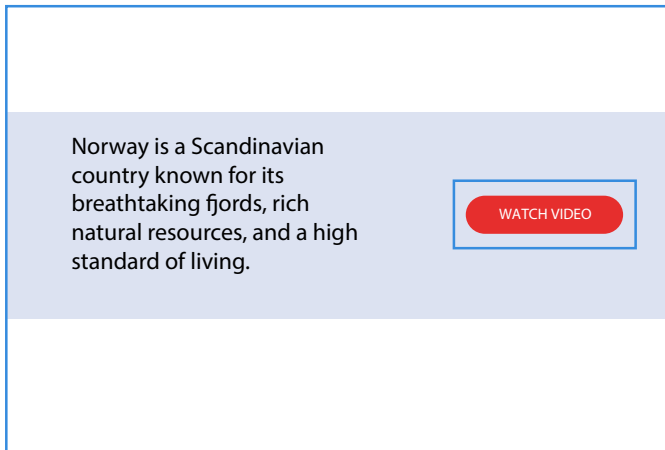


Some sections have an arrow pointing to the right. Click on the arrow or on the button “Start” button to see the following information.

To advance between lessons in a e-module be sure to click on the “Continue” button that appears on the screen.



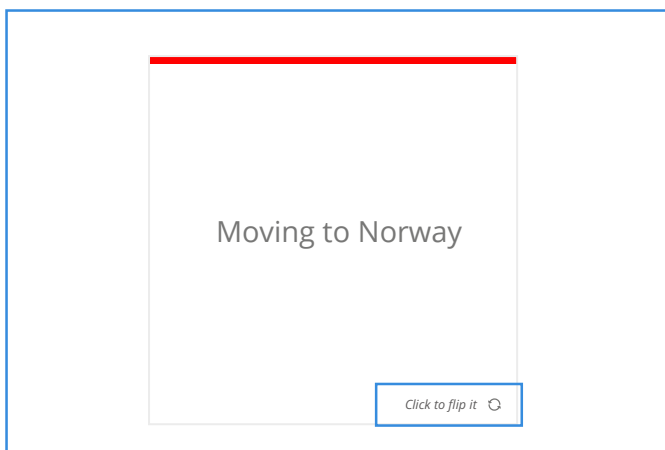
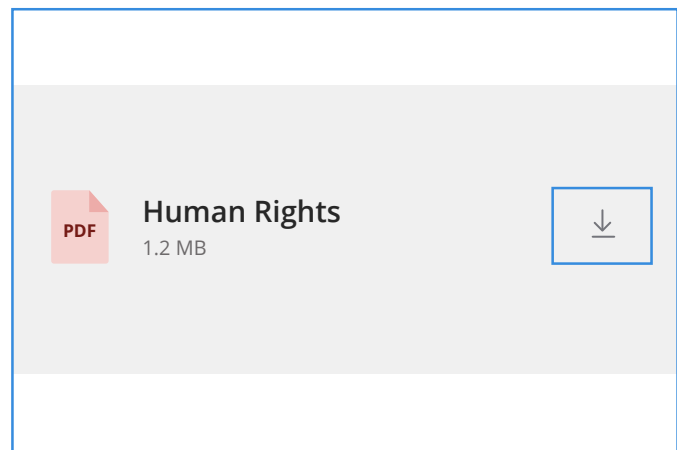
Some lessons nclude a "+" symbol that you can select to reveal hidden descriptions and information.

You can download additional documents by clicking on the download icon.

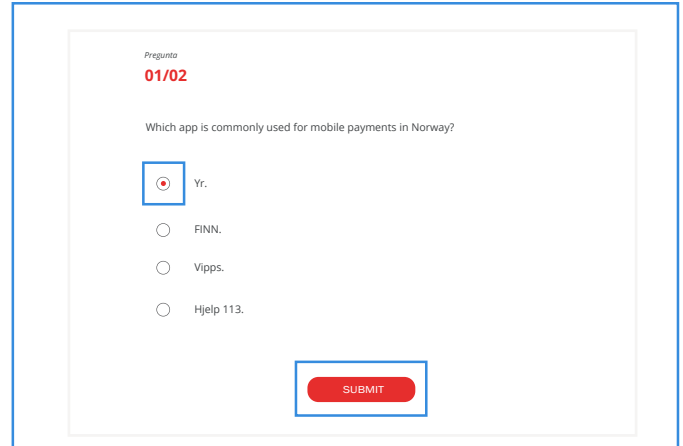


Throughout the e-modules you will also find interactive components called "flip cards".

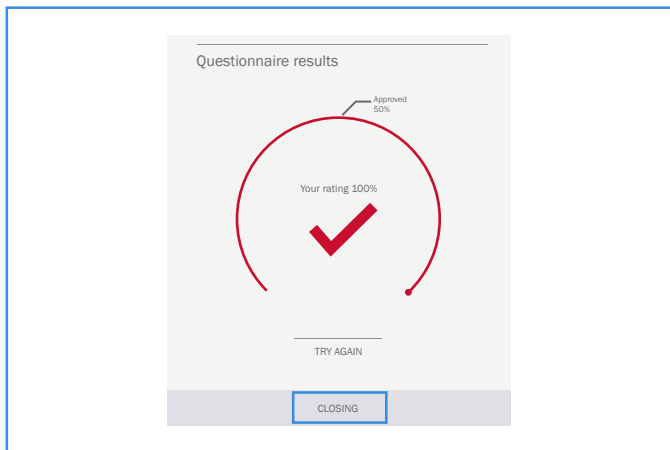
Click on these interactive elements to flip them over and discover the descriptions on the reverse side.
